As EDUKANS is committed to achievement of the MDGs in respect to Education and Poverty reduction. In order to address these, it is focusing on the strategies outlined: -

- Direct poverty reduction through infrastructure development, educational tools, training of service providers like teachers
- Strenthening of civil society; strengthening social groups operating in the sentre
 of society, the power of certain social groups to address the government to take its
 responsibility
- Lobby and advocacy; What implementing partner organizations specifically do to press the government to devote itself to education, and to realize the MDGs

However, the major focus still revolves around education as is key to development, with bias to basic education and vocational skills training. To achieve these, EDUKANS is focusing around three themes in Kenya; Education and Work, Education and HIV/AIDS and Education for Marginalized People.
