During the evaluation process the synthesis report have been assessed by an external reference group (see annex 7 of the synthesis report), and also an internal reference group has been following the evaluation process.

For Edukans, ICCO and Woord en Daad, the outcome of the evaluation has given ample insight in the quality, relevance and direct impact of the work done on TVET by their partner organisations. The evaluation stated clearly the importance of this instrument for poverty alleviation and beyond this addressed some elements that need attention in further policy formulation like capacity development and TVET, needs for innovation and the value of building strategic partnerships.

Furthermore the lessons of the synthesis report contribute also to the dialogue between the partner organisations and their co-financing agencies on relevant issues regarding TVET, such as experiments and innovation, ways of mainstreaming gender and HIV/Aids and the link of TVET and economic programmes.
