This letter of satisfaction relates to project Partners for Water project PVW06001: Integrated Water Management Support Methodologies.

### **Objectives**

The project aims were to demonstrate the use of Integrated Water Management Support Methodologies in our Kitui area (Kenya). For our specific case a demonstration of three combined tools (water allocations, water resources and multi-criteria analysis) were used to show the impact of sand dams on water demand and supply.

### **Hardware**

We didn't receive any hardware, as this was also not foreseen in the project.

### **Co-operation**

We've build up a fruitful collaboration with the partners. FutureWater, University of Amsterdam and Water Board were very collaborative and have supported us.

### **Spin-offs**

One of the striking results is that sand-dams are not harm-full to downstream users and that dams really support to overcome dry spells. More specifically, the results that even twice as many dams can be developed really helped us.

We're considering of using results in other projects and are in discussions with Future Water and Water Board in what way they can support us. Not only in the Kitui area, but also specifically in the Athi river basin we're under discussions on how to proceed.
