Re: Schools Approach: Your Reference MRDASW/CONF/12/12/(6)

Further to your letter of 12/3/92, referenced, enclosed is a revised proposal incorporating comments which were in the minutes attached to the said letter. This revised proposal should be processed in the normal channels before the next meeting.

It seems to me that the next meeting ought to get some decisions from the donors on how they may participate in funding the proposal. Their key elements for funding are :

1. Water tanks construction (Stage One)
2. Catchments in Schools (Stage Two)
3. Catchments in Communities (Stage 3)
4. Manuals Production (Stage 2)
5. Overhead
6. Total Programme for one District
7. Funding for a set of districts
8. Funding the whole package
9. Funding an expanded Programme to cover all ASALs

In my view this is necessary given that the proposal was approved subject to the revisions made. Perhaps you can, in consultation with your colleagues, structure these issues into a more elegant agenda than suggested above. What should be clear by the end of the next meeting is what are sources of funding.
