## **Background**

The University of Nairobi UNESCO/UNITWIN Chair has been undertaking backstopping tasks in conjunction with stakeholders from the Netherlands, Belgium, Tanzania and a local NGO. The tasks have mainly entailed rehydration of Arid and Semi-Arid Lands (ASALS) in Kitui District, Kenya. Specifically, the work has been to provide the intellectual input in basic research towards the construction of water retention structures, sand dams in Kitui District.

One of the glaring gaps in the project on water retention structures has been problems of research into the material and training needs for enhanced capacity building.

This document is a plan of action for the evaluation in question.

#### **Purpose of the Evaluation**

The purpose of the proposed evaluation is to investigate the history and dynamics behind water retention structures in Kitui District, Kenya. The study should come out with clear material and training needs for enhancing intervention capacity for small and sustainable water retention structures in the district.

## **Evaluation Methodology**

The evaluation methodology will be participatory and on the basis of the following procedures:

- 1. Working closely with KNATCOM, The Sahelian Solutions (SASOL) and the Kitui community.
- 2. Development of participatory tools for needs assessment.
- 3. Pretesting and revision of the tools.
- 4. Conducting fieldwork data collection using such techniques as focus group discussion, key informant interviews, review of secondary and case studies.
